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

HEDIS® Quality Measures & Maternal Health

• Generally, Virginia performs across all measure domains, roughly around the National Medicaid average, with a noted exception for maternal *HEDIS*® measures:

Timeliness of Prenatal Care

Definition: A prenatal care visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment in the health plan.

- National 50th Percentile Medicaid State Average: 84.55%
- Virginia Average: 76.01 %

Postpartum Care

Definition: A postpartum visit on or between 7 and 84 days after delivery.

- National 50th Percentile Medicaid State Average: 80.23%
- Virginia Average: 73.67%
